Unfinished Business

- Effingham County Museum J. Douthit shared roof replacement RFP has been completed with anticipated submission date
 of November 10th and bid selection at December Building and Grounds Committee meeting. J. Douthit stated RFP includes
 options of different types of material for roofing along with option to add clock tower. J. Douthit anticipates possibility of
 utilizing remaining previously earmarked ARPA funding to complete out project. T. Ellis recommended roof replacement
 RFP be sent to full board with approval of the State's Attorney. D. McCain seconded. Unanimous. *Motion carried*.
- Historic Courtyard and Gazebo Project J. Douthit reported payment plan in place for contract. J. Douthit updated committee with project status of demolition complete and drainage currently under construction. J. Douthit confirmed his project oversight will continue throughout progress of project to completion.

New Business

- Pre-Trial Services Lease Sheriff Kuhns stated lease is to expire the end of December. Sheriff Kuhns recommended noncompete clause be added to lease agreement. Discussion on possibility of non-compete clauses to be added to all lease agreements.
