Lottery for position on General Primary Election Ballot - Wednesday, December 6, 2023 - 9:00 a.m.

Candidates must file the following papers:

- a. Statement of Candidacy (SBE P-1)
- b. Loyalty Oath (Optional) (SBE P-1C)
- c. Receipt for filing Statement of Economic Interests (not required for Precinct Committeemen)
- d. Nominating petition sheets containing a sufficient number of original signatures.
(County Officers SBE P-10, County Board P-26, Precinct Committeemen P-27)
