West & Co. – FY23 Financial Statements

David Faller presented highlights of the FY23 Annual Audit Report. Net position increased \$316,000, Cash & CD's increased \$374,000, Cash decreased \$126,000 due to the purchase of the CD. The major capital highlights were the initial payment on the fire simulcast system made in 2023 and there was no debt. After the Board's review, the FY23 audit will be accepted at the regular scheduled March 911 meeting.

Financial Report & Expenditure Report

A financial report was given by J Buhnerkempe showing a January 31, 2024 balance of \$1,920,758.56 along with an Expenditure Statement for bills to be approved for \$272,180.25. Included in the bills were the annual City/County Lease paid at \$106,652.00 to each entity, the conference in Texas paid at \$7,759.26, Virtual Academy online training paid \$3,180 & Indigital Annual Support for \$36,201.10. D Mahon motioned/L Thies seconded to accept the financial and approve expenditure reports. - Billie & Tina found a new on-line training company called Virtual Academy that IDPH has approved training, for the dispatchers. During the demo, they were shown Virtual Academy Communication Training Officer & Policy Management tracking solutions. They received a quote for \$3,180 for Master Virtual Academy PSAP Solution Agreement \$3,180 annually for all 3 packages. This software was budgeted in this year's budget.
- The FCC license, for the IFERN frequency, had to be modified to the Siemer Tower location and changed to Effingham County 911, as the owner. An application had to be submitted for a new license.

- Chris Overbeck said that Global is working on a temporary fix until the radio can be installed at Siemer's.
- Tina attended an Indoor Mapping meeting on January 25th. Larger agencies have begun to prepare for being able to plot 911 calls down to what floor or apartment the 911 call is coming from.
- Tina attended the monthly 911 State Administrator's call on February 1st. The Administrator advised the TC Training Standards Committee is still working through different modules for the Mandatory Telecommunicator Training Certification.
