

RESOLVED, that sign boards meeting the specifications of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways as adopted by the Department of Public Works and Buildings, Division of Highways on June 1, 1936, be erected on such highways under the direction of the County Superintendent of Highways or the Department of Public Works and Buildings, if they deem that necessary, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the establishment of said building or set back lines does not constitute the taking of private property but is a declaration of the intention by the Effingham County Board of Supervisors to make adequate provisions for such conveniences and safety, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the provisions of this Resolution will be enforced by the Board of Supervisors of Effingham County and that the State Aid Road Committee and the County Superintendent of Highways are hereby directed to enforce the same, and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Resolution become effective and in force as soon as it is adopted by the Board of Supervisors, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Clerk is hereby directed to transmit two certified copies of this Resolution to the Department of Public Works and Buildings, Division of Highways, Springfield, Illinois, through its District Engineer.
