**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A TITLE VI POLICY FOR EFFINGHAM COUNTY PURSUANT TO THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 AND THE CIVIL RIGHTS RESTORATION ACT OF 1987; APPROVING THE ASSOCIATED LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PLAN; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE SAID POLICY ON BEHALF OF EFFINGHAM COUNTY AND APPOINT A TITLE VI LIAISON; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**Whereas**, Effingham County received a grant from the United States Department of Transportation, Federal Transit Administration, for a public transportation system in Effingham County; and

**Whereas**, recipients of Federal Transit Administration funding must establish a Title VI Policy, including a Limited English Proficiency Plan, pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF EFFINGHAM COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

**Section 1.** That the Title VI Policy, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is, and the same hereby is, approved both as to both form and substance.

**Section 2.** That the associated Limited English Proficiency Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is, and the same hereby is, approved as to both form and substance.

**Section 3.** That the County Board Chairman is hereby authorized to execute the Title VI Plan and associated Limited English Proficiency Plan and appoint a Title VI Liaison.

**Section 4.** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its adoption and approval.
