This report is submitted in accordance with 50 ILCS 70/1 et seq., the Decennial Committee on Local Government Efficiency Act (the ACT)

The Shumway Fire Protection District Decennial Efficiency Committee was formed by the Board of Trustees of the Shumway Fire Protection District (District) pursuant to the requirements of the Act and was comprised of District Trustees David Budde, Tracy Sutter, Danny Klepzig, Randy Thoele, and Doug Thies. Fire Chief Joe Kemme, Matthew Brown and Matthew Childerson. And District residents Mellisa Paholke, Ron Walls and Brad Hastings.

The committee held meetings on the following Dates: January, 13th, 2024 March 9th, 2024 and July 13th, 2024

The Shumway Fire Protection District is a public Fire Protection District organized and operating pursuant to the provisions of the Illinois Fire Protection District Act (70 ILCS 705/0.01 et seq)

The District is governed by an elected board of Trustees comprised of 5 members.

The District provides Fire Protection and rescue services and first responder medical to the residents and property owners in a territory which is approximately 70 square miles in size and located in Effingham County.

The District supports and funds a fire department comprised of 25 members. The members are volunteer.

The Districts Fire Dept. operates from 2 stations located at 14949 N Park Rd., Effingham, Il. Built in the 1980's and 206 E. Market, Shumway, Il , built in the 1970's

The District owns and operates the following apparatus

3 Engines

2 Tanker Trucks

1 Brush Truck

- 2 First Responder Vehicles

The Districts equalized assessed value is 151,873.00 based on the most recent available information.

The Districts most recent tax levy totaled 558,873.00 and was comprised of the following Levies, General \$520,000.00 Insurance \$30,000.00 and Audit \$8,670.00.

The Districts most recent budget and appropriations ordinance totaled \$2,038,029.00

The Fire Dept. does provide Emergency Medical Services, EMS is provided at the first responder level. The Districts resource hospital is Sara Bush Lincoln.

The committee reviewed the following in performing it's duties under the act.

Relevant provisions of the Illinois Fire Protection Act.

Shared services/intergovernmental agreements including mutual aid agreements, MABAS agreements, EMS agreements.

The Districts current policies and ordinances, by laws, and other internal documents.

The committee solicited input from the public regarding how the District and Department could be Made more efficient and effective.

Based on it's work the committee concluded that the District is operating in a generally efficient manner given it's financial resources, personnel, facilities, and equipment.

The committee concluded that the Districts greatest needs in order to maintain or improve it's efficiency in delivering the services it provides to the public are (see attached)

The committee concludes that the services provided by the District and the Fire Dept. are essential to the residents and property owners of the District, but that addressing the needs identified above in a timely and sufficient manner will be necessary to maintain the efficiency of the District.

Upon submission of the report, the committee is dissolved in accordance with the act.
