## **Dispatch Report/Mutual Aid Report**

- RuralMed shared reporting for months of February and March.
  - February report of 512 total requests for ambulance; 308 911 requests; 72 private line requests; 77 refusals; 109 other calls; 3 mutual aids given; 16 mutual aids received; 4 standbys.
  - March report of 507 total requests for ambulance; 306 911-requests; 65 private line requests; 49 refusals; 99 other calls; 13 mutual aids given; 23 mutual aids received; 1 standby.

# **Recruitment (training, certifications)**

- RuralMed reported one new hire for February.
- RuralMed reported no new hires for March.

### **Quality Compliance**

- RuralMed report showed February chute time average 1 minute 34 seconds; response time average 7 minutes 31 seconds; scene time average 17 minutes 31 seconds.
- RuralMed report showed March chute time average 1 minute 34 seconds; response time average 6 minutes 47 seconds; scene time average 19 minutes 30 seconds.

#### **Rural Med Contract**
