Old Business

- 1. Status of Equipment Purchases -
 - Both tandem truck cab and chassis are expected soon, but unsure when dump body will be completed.
 - Received one of the bush hog mowers approved last month and expect to receive second mower in April.
 - Still have not received flashing stoplights for 4-way near lake sara
- 2. Status of ARPA Funds for Township Drainage Structures remaining larger projects should be completed soon.

New Business

- 1. Participate in 20256/2026 CMS Joint Purchase for 300 Tons of Rock Salt T. Ellis motioned and N. Soltwedel seconded to authorize Koester to participate in CMS Rock Salt Program.
- 2. Joint Resolution to Replace Drainage Structure Along County Line at Joint Expense with Shelby County Both counties agreed to replace a large culvert located one-quarter mile west of 700th Street along Shelby/Effingham County line. Total cost is estimated at \$15,000. Division of costs will be prorated per each county's EAV (per statute); consequently, Effingham will be responsible for \$10,000, while Shelby will be responsible for \$5,000. T. Ellis moved and N. Soltwedel seconded to recommend board approval, unanimous.
- 3. Night-time Sign Inspection The annual inspection was completed with no significant concerns.
- 4. Oil Letting Scheduled for April 24th Koester anticipates lower oil prices than last year.
- 5. Local Agency Agreement for Federal Participation, South Altamont Still waiting on approved draft from IDOT. T. Ellis motioned and N. Soltwedel seconded to recommend board approval; if get approved draft by IDOT, unanimous.
- 6. Status of Maintenance Bushue discussed the following:
 - Bumping/brooming roads
 - Mobile patcher
 - Shouldering
 - Ditches...drainage
 - Douglas Township boom mower behind guardrails
 - Haul rock
- 7. Rescheduling April Committee Meeting from April 15th to April 14th Committee agreed to make change.
