- Opioid Funding – Committee review of opioid funding balance.
  - T. Ellis stated he attended ROSC meeting and they may be interested in securing funding for transportation needs.
  - N. Soltwedel inquired on School Resource Officer ability to do presentations at schools. T. Buhnerkempe confirmed they do some presentations at times, however there are only two assigned resource officers in county, one for west side and one for east side.
  - N. Soltwedel inquired if schools keep Narcan on site. T. Buhnerkempe confirmed through school resource officer that some school nurses have it on site.
  - T. Buhnerkempe reported eight participants currently enrolled in MARS program. Sheriff Kuhns shared plans to seriously look at a re-entry officer position who would know where resources are, do follow-ups, and reporting to Sheriff assisting in successful re-entry into society for participants.
  - Discussion on housing needs for opioid recovery.
